Subject: Golf Cart Testing

The Chowchilla Police Department will be conducting golf cart motorized quadricycle testing on Saturday, August 02, 2008, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The testing will be held in the old court house parking lot at the corner of Trinity Avenue and South Second Street. The testing will be given on a first come first serve basis and will take approximately ten minutes to complete. The cost for a Golf Cart License is \$15.00.

The Chowchilla Municipal Code allows the operation of motorized quadricycles/golf carts by properly licensed seniors ages sixty-two (62) and older, and by persons who by reason of physical disability are unable to move about as a pedestrian. Each person participating in the testing must bring their own golf cart with a slow moving vehicle triangle in place on the back of the golf cart. The test will consist of a driving course to ensure the golf cart can be operated safely by the driver.

These regulations can be found in Chowchilla Municipal Code Sections 10.46.010, 10.46.020, 10.46.030, 10.46.040, and 10.46.050. Copies of the sections are also available in the lobby of the Chowchilla Police Department.
