**Subject: Quadricycle/Golf Cart Testing**

The Chowchilla Police Department will be conducting golf cart and motorized quadricycle testing on Saturday, May 24, 2008, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The testing will be held in the parking lot at the corner of Trinity Avenue and South Second Street. The testing will be given on a first-come, first-serve basis and will take approximately ten minutes to complete. The cost for a Golf Cart License is \$15.

Quadricycles/Golf Cart use is for seniors ages sixty-two (62) and older and for persons who by reason of physical disability are unable to move about as a pedestrian. Each person must bring their own cart with a slow moving vehicle triangle in place on the back of the cart. The test will consist of a driving course to ensure the cart can be driven safely.
