Licenses expire December 31 every year

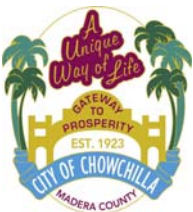


**The fee is \$9.00 for altered dogs and \$18.00 for unaltered dogs.
Senior Discount is \$4.50 for altered dogs and \$9.00 for unaltered dogs.**

Note: A \$20 late fee will be added to all fees after April 1.

Chowchilla Municipal Code 6.04.250 states all dogs residing within the City of Chowchilla limits that are over the age of four months must be vaccinated for rabies and licensed through the Chowchilla Police Department. Proof of rabies vaccination is required in order to obtain a dog license. You must also show proof of dog's alteration in order to receive licensing discounts.

To obtain or renew a license, come to the Chowchilla Police Department during regular business hours (call for hours). *Renewals only in the form of cashiers check or money order payable to the City of Chowchilla may be mailed in to the department (see address below). *Proof of current rabies vaccination must also be included if not on file or if it has expired.

ANNUAL RABIES CLINICS

Rabies Clinics are held every year, one in the spring and one in the fall, at the Chowchilla Police Department Station located at 122 Trinity Avenue. Times run from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. for seniors or those disabled and 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for the general public. Distemper/Parvo, rabies, and worming shots will be available for dogs. FVRCD, rabies, and worming shots will be available for cats. ALL cats MUST be in carriers. Call 559-665-8600 for more information.
