RESOLUTION # 50-10**

**A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT THE ANNUAL ASSESSMENT FOR
LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE AND LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 90-1
OF THE CITY OF CHOWCHILLA**

On July 12, 2010 at its regular meeting, the City Council of the City of Chowchilla adopted Resolution 50-10, a Resolution of Intention to Levy and Collect the Annual Assessment for Landscape Maintenance and Lighting District No. 90-1. The Resolution read as follows:

**A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT
THE ANNUAL ASSESSMENT FOR LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE AND
LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 90-1 OF THE CITY OF CHOWCHILLA**

WHEREAS, It is the intention of the Chowchilla City Council to order the levy and collection of assessment under the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Part two of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code (beginning with Section 22500 of said Code and hereinafter the "Act") for the City of Chowchilla Landscape Maintenance and Lighting District No. 90-1, (herein the "District"), and

WHEREAS, the territory of said District comprised of various territories generally located on the attached vicinity map which is the real property benefited and to be assessed for the maintenance and operation of the landscaping facilities in said District generally described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has prepared and filed with the Clerk of the City of Chowchilla a report **labeled Engineer's Report of the City of Chowchilla Landscape Maintenance and Lighting District No. 90-1, 2010-2011 Tax Year**, to which reference is hereby made for a description of the existing improvements, new improvements, any substantial changes in existing improvements, the boundaries of the assessment district and any zones therein (including the general location), and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within District, and

WHEREAS, The Chowchilla News, a newspaper published and circulated in the City of Chowchilla is hereby designated as the newspaper in which this Resolution of Intention shall be published upon adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Chowchilla that it hereby resolves, finds and orders:

1. That the above recitals are true and correct.
2. The Acting City Clerk of the City of Chowchilla is hereby directed to cause this Resolution of Intention to be published once in the Chowchilla News not less than ten (10) days before the date set for hearing.
3. That the **9th day of August, 2010 at the hour of 7:00 p.m.** in the regular meeting place of the City Council of the City of Chowchilla, that is, the Council Chambers, City Hall, 130 Second Street, Chowchilla, California, 93610, is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where all interested persons shall be heard of the question of the levy and collection of the proposed assessments.
4. Written protests may be filed with the City Clerk at any time prior to the conclusion of the hearing. A written protest shall state all grounds of objection and shall contain a description sufficient to identify the property owner by the protesting person or persons.
5. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
